Girls Notes: No entry required - show up and coaches set up matches. Be kind and don't take over a facility and dominate court time. If 4 teams are at a 4 court facility then 2 teams can dual on 2 courts or give one court to each team and they have that court and can grab whatever matches they want. Just be kind and patient!

- 1. Scoring will be abbreviated sets starting at 2-2. Traditional 3rd set tie break.
- 2. I added some teams so it is pretty tight-schedule is not perfect but it is a logistical nightmare creating a tourney at this many locations with so many locations. The intent is to get teams together from across the state---if you need a match with a team I have openings to play those matches. It is amazing we have teams from Baker to Wolf Point to Troy. This is a great vision of our state!
- 3. Teams supply own balls.
- 4. Adhere to time schedule and be on time for matches!
- 5. If a court time slot is open it is available for exhibitions.
- 6. If moving locations in back to back matches consider taking team in 2 waves so the dual can start as the other one can finish.
- 7. Pick up own trash!

- **9.** When B-C teams play it will be singles 1-4 and doubles 1-2.
